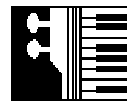

**Clarinet Days 2007**  
**The Advanced Course**  
December 5<sup>th</sup>-11<sup>th</sup> 2007

Dear clarinet teachers and players,

The Clarinet Days course will be held for the eighth time this Hanukah. We are delighted that most of the activity this year will take place at the Buchman-Mehta School of Music of the Tel-Aviv University, and we extend our appreciation to Prof. Tomer Lev, head of the school, for his cooperation and support of the course.

As always the course will host some of the best clarinet teachers in the world:

**Guy Deplus** – France

**Reiner Wehle** – Germany

**Wolfgang Meyer** – Germany

**Evgeny Petrov** – Russia

And the following teachers from Israel: **Richard Lesser, Shirley Brill,**

**Iliya Schwartz and Sarah Elbaz.**

**The orchestras that will accompany the course participants are: The Israel Chamber Orchestra conducted by Vag Papian and the IDF Orchestra conducted by Lt. Col. Michael Ya'aran.**

At the request of the guest artists, the course will be in the following format:

The main course for advanced students and players will take place between December 5<sup>th</sup> and 11<sup>th</sup> and will include 30 players. Each player will have one teacher accompanying him throughout the course, who will give him several lessons, at least one of which will be a master class in front of an audience. Since the number of participants is limited precedence will be given to players 18 years of age and over, however at least 10 participants will be under 18 years of age. Players not accepted to the course will be invited to a master class with the guest artists during the Young Clarinetist Day on December 9<sup>th</sup>.

The course will conclude with two **festive concerts** with the orchestras.

The first concert will take place on Sunday, December 9<sup>th</sup> at 16:00 at the **Claremont Hall, Buchman-Mehta School of Music of the Tel-Aviv University.**

The second concert will take place on Monday, December 10<sup>th</sup> at 17:00 at the **Jerusalem Theatre's Henry Crown Hall, and will be broadcast on the radio live on Etnachta, presented by Ms. Hayuta Dvir.**

This concert will conclude a day of activity at the Jerusalem Music Center including **master classes and a recital by Clarinetist Reiner Wehle and Pianist Arnon Erez.**



**All concerts are free admission and parents are invited to attend and to bring additional guests.**

The pieces to be performed with the orchestras are:

Weber: Concertino Op. 26

Weber: Concerto for Clarinet and Orchestra No. 1 in F minor Op. 73.

Rossini: Introduction Theme and Variations for Clarinet and Orchestra

Rimsky-Korsakov – Concerto for Clarinet and Concert Band – for players up to 16 years of age.

Artie Shaw – Clarinet Concerto

One soloist per movement will be chosen for the Weber Concerto No. 1.

Since there are 2 final concerts different soloists may be chosen for each concert, thus enabling the participation of more soloists.

**Soloist selection:** On the first day of the course: December 5<sup>th</sup> at 20:00 an audition, open to the public, will be held at the Auditorium of the Israel Conservatory, Tel Aviv (Shtriker St.). The jury for the audition will include: Guy Deplus, Reiner Wehle, Wolfgang Meyer, Richard Lesser and Shirley Brill. The jury's decision is final.

Course repertoire is not limited. Players who do not wish to audition to play with the orchestras may choose to work with the teachers at the course on any piece they have prepared.

Course tuition: 900 NIS not including accommodation.

Students from distant places will be invited to stay at the homes of local students. The Bnei Dan Hostel is also available for 200 NIS a night.

The activity on Friday Decembet 7<sup>th</sup> will finish at 15:00 and students will be able to return to their homes until Sunday morning.

Final registration date: November 30<sup>th</sup>.
